NOMINATION CRITERIA: DIRECTORS



Demonstrated Boardroom Impact

Nominees should demonstrate recent board-level contributions that materially strengthened governance oversight, strategy, or organizational resilience (ideally within the past 24 months.)

Examples:

- strengthening board oversight frameworks
- guiding boards through major strategic transformation
- advancing cyber, technology, or AI oversight
- improving executive compensation governance
- strengthening risk oversight or regulatory readiness
- improving CEO succession oversight
- enhancing board decision-making processes

Governance Influence & Modernization

Nominees should demonstrate the ability to strengthen governance practices and influence how boards oversee emerging challenges. This category evaluates how directors help boards modernize governance frameworks and advance oversight practices.

Examples:

- modernizing board governance structures or committee oversight
- strengthening oversight of emerging risks (AI, cyber, geopolitical risk)
- improving capital allocation oversight
- strengthening board culture and governance processes
- contributing to governance dialogue through NACD engagement, thought leadership, or mentoring

Leadership & Governance Credibility

Nominees should demonstrate recognized stature as a corporate director and be respected for their ethical leadership, informed judgment across complex governance matters, and mature confidence in advising boards and executives.

Examples:

- exhibiting courage and leadership under duress, doing what is best for the corporation and its shareholders in the face of countervailing pressures inside or outside the boardroom
- having a track record for actions that have guided their company in maintaining consistent, long-term profitability, pursuing significant business opportunities, improving shareholder returns, and/or dealing effectively with a crisis or other major change
- valuing board and team performance over individual performance, keeping ego in check
- fostering an environment of constant improvement of strategic goals, performance, and innovation

NOMINATION CRITERIA: GOVERNANCE PROFESSIONALS



Meaningful Boardroom Impact

Nominees should demonstrate recent contributions that strengthened governance practices or board oversight (ideally within the past 24–36 months).

Examples:

- modernizing board governance structures in shifting landscapes
- supporting robust board evaluation and board and CEO succession
- strengthening board risk oversight frameworks
- advancing cyber, technology, or AI governance
- improving executive compensation governance
- supporting board decision-making during strategic change or risk events

Governance Influence

Nominees should demonstrate the ability to influence governance practices and support effective board leadership.

Examples:

- advising boards or board committees
- shaping governance frameworks or policies
- advancing governance modernization
- contributing to industry governance dialogue or policy discussions

Leadership & Expertise

Nominees should have recognized expertise and leadership within the governance profession and be respected for their ethical leadership, informed judgment across complex governance matters, and mature confidence in advising boards and executives. They are viewed by peers as trusted advisors who contribute constructively within the evolving governance ecosystem.

Examples:

- leadership of governance-relevant functions or advisory practices
- governance credentials or professional recognition
- publications, speaking engagements, or governance thought leadership
- peer recognition as a trusted advisor to boards or governance leaders

B. KENNETH WEST LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The recipient of this award will be selected on the basis of distinguished service on public, private, and/or nonprofit boards over an extended period of time. He or she should be a **career-long model** of the four standards of exemplary director professionalism and may be either a current or a retired director.

In addition, a nominee should demonstrate dedication to the improvement of corporate governance practices, as evidenced by a reputation among peers and in the business community for excellent leadership. His or her exceptional achievements should have an impact that is visible in boardrooms today.

Nominations should endeavor to illuminate the full scope of achievements throughout the nominee's board career.

Eligible nominees must currently serve on at least one public, private, or nonprofit board and hold a leadership role, such as chairing a board committee, where they have demonstrated meaningful contributions to board effectiveness and oversight.
